It includes 2021 data

It accommodates legislation information that gets implemented in the country on or before December 31, 2022

Monitoring **Tool**

Requested by UNGA and WHA resolutions to track progress towards global goals and assess progress during 2011-2020 Decade of Action

Baseline for the 2021-2030 Decade of Action, to inform interventions during the new decade towards the SDG 3.6



A product of **two-year process** using a **standard questionnaire** with **contributors** from across the world

Methodology

Standardized questionnaire

- Questionnaire comprises of **87 questions** in **14 Sections**:

SECTION A. Road traffic deaths and non-fatal injuries due to road traffic crashes

SECTION B. Strategy and targets

SECTION C. Information systems

SECTION D. Exposure to risk of road traffic crashes

SECTION E. Infrastructure

SECTION F. Vehicles

SECTION G. Insurance

SECTION H. Speed control

SECTION I. Impaired driving

SECTION J. Use of protective devices

SECTION K. Post-Crash Response

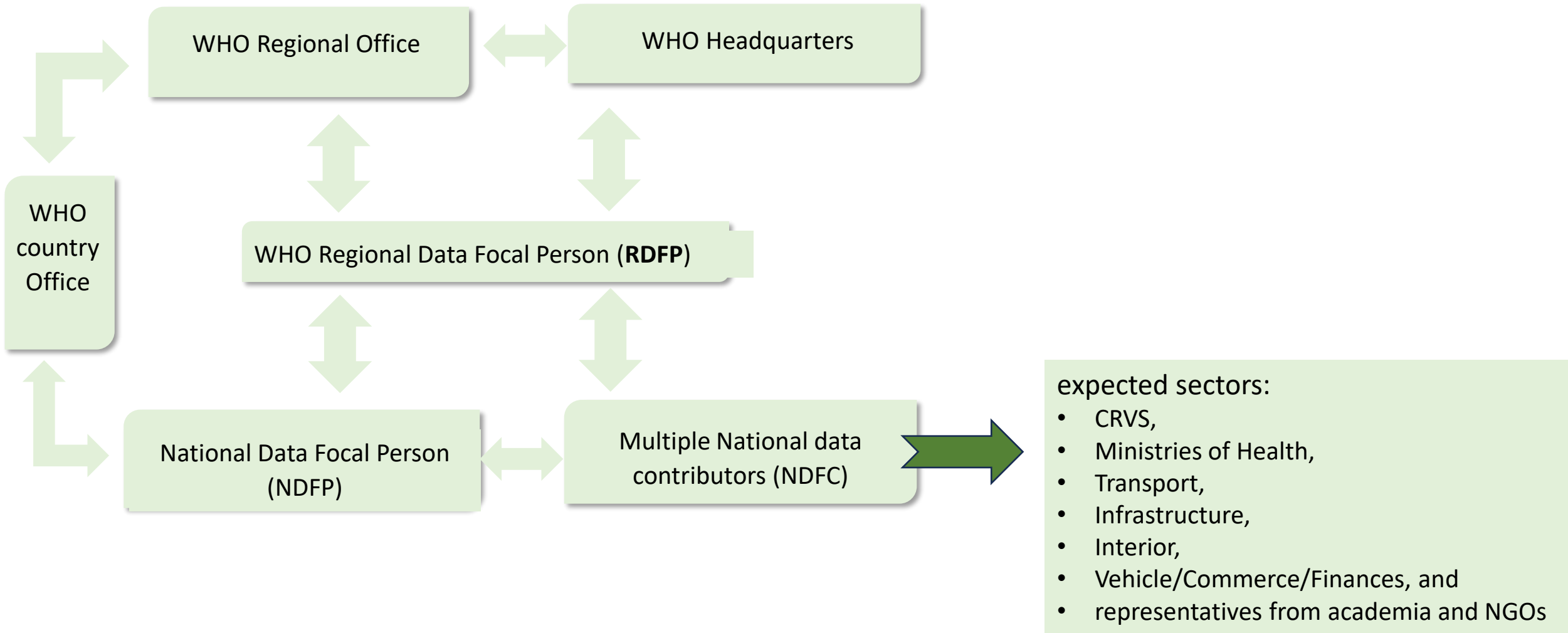

Methodology

Who were involved



Methodology

Data collection process

NDFP nominated by their government



NDFP participates in on-line training



NDFP works with WRO to develop detailed work plan with clear timeline and deliverables



NDFP (supported by RDFP, WCOs and HQ) identifies national data contributors in their country



Contributors receive training from NDFP about their expected roles and get access to the questionnaire.



Data Contributors each give response to the QUESTIONNAIRE and collect any supporting documents they submit



Consensus meeting held: NDFP and data contributors go through each question on the questionnaire and together decide which response best represents their country situation. Complete the FINAL QUESTIONNAIRE



NDFP submit the answers to the questionnaire



NDFP works with WHO staff to validate the information submitted, resolve any consistencies, etc.



HQ summarizes the country data and sends them to NDFP together with a “sign-off sheet”



NDFP shares a copy of FINAL COUNTRY QUESTIONNAIRE to relevant authorities and facilitates government clearance process



Government approves the data in the “sign-off sheet” for publication
