Motorcycle taxis around the world

There are ~20 million motorcycle taxis around the world.¹ They are extremely common across Asia, Africa, and Latin America, due in large part to existing transportation planning. Particularly in places with limited public transport, motorcycle taxis, alongside other formal and informal services like tuk-tuks and minivans, emerge as vital mobility lifelines. Together, these modes likely move more people globally than all other modes of transportation combined.

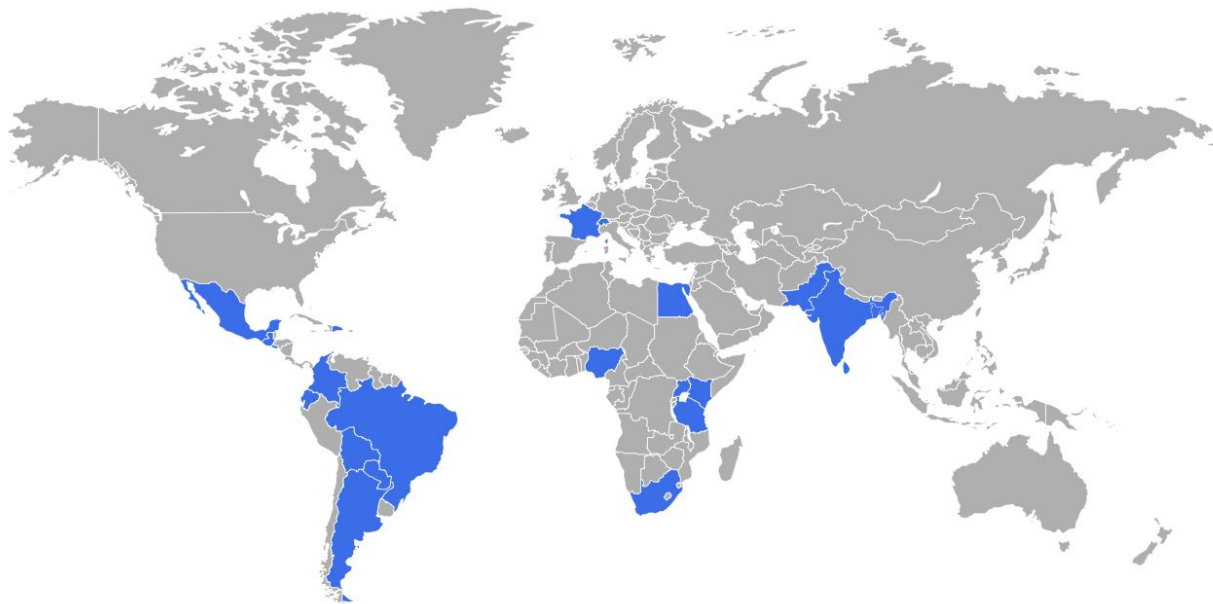
